

WHAT ARE THE ARCHITECTS RIGHTS

Section 7

- 1. Practice/run business/take up employment for ACP
- 2. Can call himself a "Proffessional Architect"
- 3. Can display sign board, card and other device as Prof. Arch.
- 4. Can use the abbreviation Ar. / P. Arch
- 5. Can charge fee/rumenaration for services rendered

Section 8

6. Can perform work under architects entitlement sec 8 arch act

WHAT ARE THE ARCHITECTS ROLES

- 1. To interpret & implement Design Intentions
- 2. To ensure final completion of the Project
- 3. Ensure Client's Interest Protected
- 4. Submission and Approvals of Plans
- 5. Advice need of engagement of other consultant
- 6. Administer Building Contract

WHAT ARE THE ARCHITECTS RESPONSIBILITY

- 1. Professional- Clients certifier, agent ,adviser
- 2. Contractual- Quasi arbitrator, certifier, keep time & budget, contract administrator
- 3. Legal- Building compliance to Law
- 4. Moral- protect interest of public, duty care

WHAT ARE THE ARCHITECTS OBLIGATION

COPC 3 (1-8)

- Maintain professional standard of service of himself & employee
- Administer building contract competently, responsibly & impartial
- 3. Exercise reasonable standard of skill & diligence
- Notify client in writing prior commencing architectural consultancy services
- Shall not certify / affix / put signatures to documents not prepared / supervise by him

WHAT ARE THE ARCHITECTS LIABILITY

- 1. Design default
- 2. Cost over run
- 3. Poor project/ contract management
- 4. Bad and wrong advice
- 5. Certification mistake and premature
- 6. Late issuance information
