
FMA Australia

- FMA Australia has broad industry support, a turnover of A\$1.6 mil pa, a staff of 8 and over 1,800 members







- Employs 2.10% Australia's workforce (172,000)*




- structure and mobilisation, some 65 volunteers

- commenced FM Exemplar Project : Sydney Opera House to research integrated FM solutions






Implementation phase highlights 2006-07;
